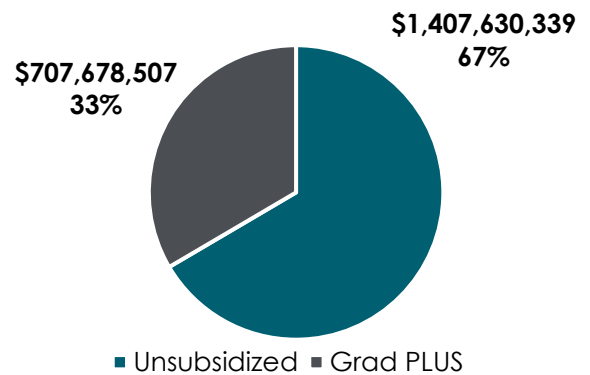
Enrollment

- **4709** were law students (JD).

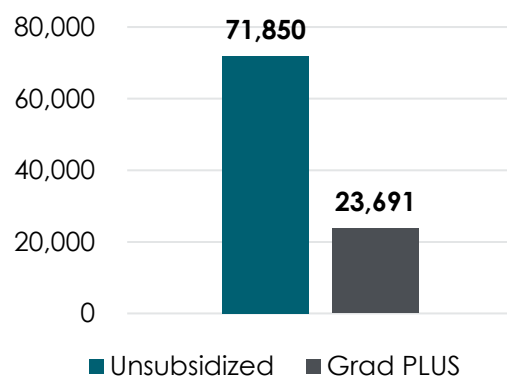
Degrees Awarded

- **1371** were law students (JD).

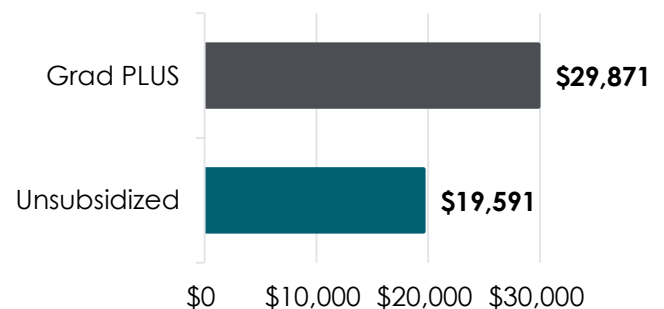
Federal Direct Loan Dollars by Graduate Loan Program
