




What is Intersectionality?





optional

- · hobbies & passions

secret ingredients

- · personal experiences
- changes to other ingredients
 hidden identities
- · misperception of ingredients











Procedure:

Combine base ingredients to create broth and bring to a boil. Add early additions and simmer over low heat for 18 - 25 years, adding optional and secret ingredients to taste. Makes one You.
