Program Overview: Purpose

• The LexScholars Post-Baccalaureate Program (LexPostBacc) is a deferred admission program that provides law schools with a means of broadening access to legal education to promising applicants who are likely to benefit from additional preparation and exposure prior to starting law school.





Program Overview: Purpose

 The purpose of LexPostBacc is to help prepare participants, called LexPostBacc Scholars, for the academic rigors and financial commitment of law school by exposing them to a rigorous law school prep curriculum and by providing them access to financial aid that reduces their costs of attendance.





Program Overview: Eligibility

LexPostBacc Scholars are:

- Referred by a participating law school
- First-generation bachelor's degree graduate, and/or
- Pell Grant recipient as an undergraduate
- LSAT takers with a score no higher than the 25th percentile





Program Overview: Curriculum

- Curriculum is designed to require roughly 10 hours of effort per week delivered via synchronous and asynchronous distance learning methods.
- The overarching goal is to help you become a skilled legal reader, a process that takes some law students up to a year to achieve.
 - Skilled legal readers derive meaning from legal texts accurately and efficiently.





Program Overview: Curriculum

3 Areas of Skills Development

Understanding

- The accurate recitation of facts and law
- Acquiring new vocabulary, both contextual/historical and legal terminology

Interpreting

- The accurate recounting of analytical steps
- Explaining the process by which an outcome was reached

Application

- The accurate alignment of legal rules or principles to provided facts
- Demonstrating the ability to identify relevant legal rules and explain the legal significance of facts in support of a conclusion





Program Overview: Evaluation

- Scholars are assessed based on 2 general factors:
 - Measures of Engagement
 - Measures of Performance

When a Scholar fails to meet engagement and/or performance thresholds, the referring law school may opt to rescind admission and scholarship offers.





Program Overview: Incentives

- Participants who successfully complete the LexPostBacc curriculum receive:
 - Deferred admission to the referring law school
 - A scholarship award of at least 20% tuition from the law school that offered deferred admission
- A \$7,500 stipend from AccessLex (paid in installments over the course of law school study)
- A Helix Bar Review® course, upon graduation





LexPostBacco by AccessLex

Alumni Outcomes





Alumni outcomes emerge from law school transcript and survey data collected from program Alumni each semester of law school.

 $$500 \times 6 \text{ semesters} = $3,000$

LexPostBacc Alumni Census

- Average UGPA: 3.56
- Average LSAT Percentile: 23
- 85% underrepresented in law school
- 60% first-generation graduates
- 70% women
- Median age: 26

LexPostBacc Alumni Academic Performance

... is not correlated with LSAT score percentile (r = .12, p = .23).

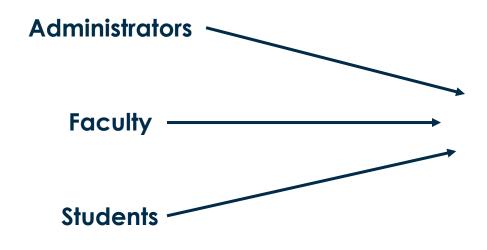



Study habits (outlining, note-taking)	48%
Time management, organizational skills	39%
Legal analysis and writing	27%

Curricular Innovations

- Increase in Writing Assignments
 - Memorandum of Law
 - Analysis and Drafting Tasks
- Extended Writing and Revision Periods
 - 1 week of Peer Review and Revision Planning
 - 1 week of Revision





Program Innovations

- 2025 Introduction of LexPostBacc Direct
 - Scholars may apply directly to the LexPostBacc Program without a referring law school.
- Application Deadline is June 1
